



TB TEST



We must have proof of a clear tuberculosis (TB) screening before you can begin working with children. This is mandated by the State of California.

If you have had a negative TB screening within the *last four years*, simply *provide us with a copy of it*.

If you need a TB test, you can get one from your private physician or Kaiser Permanente if you are a member.

Closed on Thursday

Friday: 10 am – noon; 1 pm – 4 pm (closed noon – 1 pm)

Important: *You will need to return to the clinic 2-3 days after your TB test to have it read.*

Directions:

From the North:

Take US-101 South toward San Francisco. Take the I-580 exit toward Richmond Bridge/Oakland. Keep right at the fork following signs for Francisco Blvd. Turn left on Bellam Blvd. Turn right onto Francisco Blvd E/The Loop. The Health and Wellness Center will be on your right in about 3/10 of a mile.

From the South:

Take US-101 North towards Eureka. Take the Francisco Blvd. Exit. Turn left on Bellam Blvd. Turn right onto Francisco Blvd E/The Loop. The Health and Wellness Center will be on your right in about 3/10 of a mile.

After you have obtained a TB clearance:
