## ADULT LEAGUES

### Marin Ladies League

Doubles only ladies league that is played in Marin County. Matches from September through April, but practices throughout the year. No USTA rating needed.

### Sonoma Napa Marin League

Singles and doubles ladies league that is played in all three counties, both home and away. Matches from September through April. No USTA rating needed.

### Twilight League

Doubles league that runs from May through July. The men's, women's and mixed doubles matches are played in the evenings, in Marin County. No USTA rating needed.

### USTA Leagues

Men's and women's adult leagues run from April through August. Senior leagues run from September-February; Mixed leagues January-May. USTA rating needed. Matches played in Marin County.

### Junior Spring/Fall Classes

Junior players are offered the chance to keep their skills sharp through after school instruction at the club. Players ages 4 - 14 may sign up for the classes, which run in two sessions; September-November and March-May.

Juniors who are interested in playing tennis competitively should sign up for one or both of our two Jr. Leagues. The Spring League features singles and doubles inter-club play. Practice times are flexible and matches are played throughout the county.

The Fall League is an intra-club league played on a very flexible schedule. Played in a Round Robin format, kids are matched up with others based on their ability.
